



Corporate Matching Opportunity

Many employers will match charitable contributions made by their employees. Your company may have a corporate matching gift program. To find out if your company has this program ask your Human Resources Officer or Corporate Representative. If the answer is yes, find out if your company has a form to fill out or use the form included separately on our website, make a photocopy for your own records and give the original to your Human Resources Officer.

Other Corporate Opportunities

When many companies learn of an employees' dedication to a charity(s) they are more than willing to support employees fundraising goals. Do you know if the company you work for participates in a corporate giving program? To find out how your company participates in charitable programs ask your Human Resources Officer.

Your company may be willing to help in a variety of ways:

- Pledge a set amount or fixed donation
- Match, dollar for dollar, all money raised by an employee or corporate team
- Pay a percentage of the money raised by an employee or corporate team
- Pledge a donation in the name of each of your company's team members
- Pay a corporate team's registration fee (employees could name the team after the company and wear company t-shirts to advertise)
- Support fundraising activities that employees may want to hold at the office, such as company pledge drives, office spare change jars, corporate lotto, bake sales, jeans day and BBQs (review the Pledge Kit for more details on these ideas)
